2019 Sporting Clays Fundraising Shoot

Shooters Guide

- Registration and continental breakfast begin at 8:00 am at the clubhouse.
- Lucky Target tickets are \$10 for two, \$20 for five. Firearm prize.
- Eye and ear protection are required.
- Swear jar fundraiser. Each team sets their own fine. Team with largest donation wins a prize for each team member.
- Shoot begins with safety briefing at 8:45am.
- Team pictures and start the course at 9:00 am. Shotgun start.
- Maximum load allowed: 7 1/2 shot; 1 1/8 ounce; 3 drams powder.
- Shooters pick up their own shells.
- If the trap breaks the clay, start a new pair.
- Shooters do not keep their own score. Shooter name and scorer signature must be different.
- 16 Stations, most with 3 pairs.
- Turkey Shoot at outdoor pistol range on the way back to the clubhouse. \$5.00 per shot, gun and ammo provided. Most holes in card in 2" circle, closest to crossbar is tie breaker.
- Lunch, raffles, silent auction, and awards after course completion.
- All firearms must be stored away after the course completion, prior to entering clubhouse and lunch tent.
- Ticket sales for raffles will be available during registration and lunch.
